# Welcome to your Moving In checklist

To help you feel prepared when you arrive at University, here's a rough guide to what you'll need to bring.

## TO GET YOU STARTED

Don't feel you need to bring everything with you at once, just a few basic essentials will do.

There are a range of shops on campus, in the city and online to buy the other things you need once you've moved in.

Please check opening times before visiting – in particular, some shops close around 16:00 on Sundays.

## KITCHEN


If you're moving into a **self-catered** residence, you might want to bring:

- ✓ Cutlery and basic crockery (Plate, bowl, mug and glass).
- ✓ A large and a medium saucepan, a frying pan or wok, baking tray and a chopping board.
- ✓ Cooking utensils (sharp knife, bread knife, wooden spoon, spatula and slotted spoon).
- ✓ Food storage containers.
- ✓ Cling film, tin foil, fridge/freezer bags and tea towels.

If you're moving into a **catered** residence, you will have use of a utility room and may want to bring:

- ✓ Cutlery and basic crockery (Plate, bowl, mug and glass).
- ✓ Washing up liquid, cloths and basic cleaning products.
- ✓ Cling film, tin foil, fridge/freezer bags and tea towels.

**Other items you might want to bring:**

- Cheese grater
- Vegetable peeler
- Tin and bottle opener
- Scissors

## BEDROOM / BATHROOM

- ✓ Duvet, pillows, duvet cover, pillow cases, sheet (non-fitted), blanket/throw.
- ✓ Towels, personal toiletries and toilet roll.
- ✓ Coat hangers.
- ✓ CE marked extension lead (UK plug adaptor if required) and appliance charging equipment.
- ✓ Cleaning products and cleaning cloths.

*You can use a kettle in your bedroom, but no cooking items are allowed.*

- ✓ Laundry basket and washing detergent.

Ensure you choose the correct bedding size for your residence e.g. single or double.

# Things you don't need to bring

These are the items we'll provide for you:

## In Catered Residence Utility Rooms:

- Kettle
- Microwave
- Iron and ironing board
- Mop, bucket, dust pan and brush
- Vacuum cleaner
- Recycling Bins

\*A mini fridge is provided in all catered bedrooms



## SHARE AND COLLAB

These are things you can arrange to share with your flatmates once you arrive, to split the cost and avoid having duplicates.

- ✓ Toaster
- ✓ Rice cooker
- ✓ Mixing bowls, measuring jug
- ✓ Scales
- ✓ Oven gloves
- ✓ Cleaning products



## PLEASE DO NOT BRING

These items are **not** allowed in University residences:

- ✗ Clothes airer/dryer (in bedrooms).
- ✗ Portable heaters/fan heaters.
- ✗ Candles/incense. How about using battery-lit candles instead?
- ✗ Electric blanket.
- ✗ Additional furniture.
- ✗ Plug-in decorative lights. Battery-operated lights are fine!
- ✗ Any type of adhesive fixings e.g. coat, picture hooks or white/BluTak. We ask that you only use the noticeboards to display things on your walls, so bringing drawing pins might be handy.

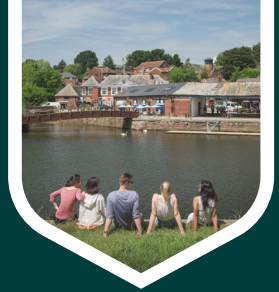
These essentials will help with your life admin:
